Additional Information

Second year scouts will have the opportunity to choose from more than 42 merit badges **Aquatics:** Swimming, Lifesaving, Rowing, Canoeing, Small Boat Sailing

Scoutcraft: Backpacking, Camping, Cooking, Orienteering, Pioneering, Hiking, Indian Lore, Wilderness Survival, Emergency Preparedness, First Aid, Safety, Fingerprinting

Handicraft: Basketry, Leatherwork, Wood Carving

Fine Arts: Art, Music, Journalism, Photography, Cinematography

Shooting Sports: Archery, Rifle, Shotgun

Ecology/Conservation (Nature): Astronomy, Bird Study, Environmental Science, Insect Study, Fish and Wildlife Management, Fishing, Forestry, Geology, Mammals, Plant Science, Reptile & Amphibian Study, Nature, Soil and Water Conservation, and Weather.

Scouts 14 years old and older will have the opportunity to take part in a high adventure TREK. This TREK has an additional fee.

The scout will go to the Cool Water Camp along the Pine River in Northern Michigan. They'll canoe the river for two days and break camp and head over to the Manistee-Huron National Forest for a camping and hiking adventure culminating in a day and night hiking and camping in the Sleeping Bear Dunes on Lake Michigan.
